<p>Objective: (Specify skills/information that will be learned.)</p>	<p>Students will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Be using fine motor skills - Follow directions step by step 	<p>Materials Needed</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2 – 8 inch Lace • 7 Pony Beads – 2 Different Colors • 1 Key Ring • Glue Gun
<p>Procedures:</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Loop 1st string through Key Ring 2) Loop 2nd string through Key Ring 3) Now there should be 4 sting dangling from Key Ring 4) Put 1st Pony Bead through the 2 middle strings 5) Put the 2nd Pony Bead through first 2 Strings (different color than the 1st Pony Bead) 6) Put the 3rd Pony Bead through the third and forth strings (same color as the 2nd Pony Bead) 7) Put the 4th Pony Bead through the 2 middle strings again (same color as the 1st Pony Bead) 8) Put the 5th Pony Bead through the first 2 strings again (same color as the 2nd Pony Bead) 9) Put the 6th Pony Bead through the third and forth strings again (same color as the 2nd Pony Bead) 10) Put the 7th Pony Bead through the middle 2 strings again (same color as 1st and 3rd Pony Bead) 11) Put a little bit of glue in middle of last Pony Bead to hold in place
